



**Application for Funding
COVID-19 Emergency Support Fund for Recreation and Sport**

Overview

The Covid-19 Emergency Support Fund for Recreation and Sport is a microgrant program that aims to support municipalities in offsetting revenue losses to recreational programs and facilities, as a result of operational changes caused by following COVID-19 public health guidelines.

Eligibility

Funding is available to municipalities with a population of less than 10,000. Successful applications will receive a microgrant for \$2,000.

Some examples of operational changes that resulted in revenue losses could include:

- lower program registrations/participation because of reductions in capacity allowances;
- decrease in the quantity of scheduled programs, events, and rental groups because of increased cleaning protocols between user groups;
- increase in staff to help with increased cleaning frequency and other guideline protocols.
