



ICE SKATING PROTECTIVE HELMET POLICY

Hodder Memorial Arena

PREAMBLE

The mandatory wearing of a Canadian Standard Association (CSA) approved protective helmets for ice sports by all participants, for their protection and safety during ice skating activities at the Hodder Memorial arena important initiative for the Town of Deer Lake, users groups, and the public at large.

POLICY STATEMENT

This policy was implemented for the safety and wellbeing of all users while participating in ice skating activities at the Hodder Memorial Arena.

POLICY

All participants during ice related activities at the Hodder Memorial Arena shall wear a Canadian Standards Association (CSA) approved protective helmet for ice sports. This policy will be clearly posted with the other established regulations for activities and placed at the entrance of Hodder Memorial Arena.

EXCEPTIONS

Figure Skaters who are registered with Skate Canada and after successfully completing the CanSkate program as well as figure skating competition during sanctioned competitions are exempt from wearing a protective helmet during these activities as standard practice in the sport which is supported by Skate Canada and Skate NL.

The policy will not apply to team personnel during bookings made by the teams associated with the Pro Hockey League.
