ICE HELMET POLICY

Policy subject: Ice Helmet Policy – Joe Byrne Memorial/Windsor Stadium

Purpose:

The mandatory wearing of a Canadian Standard Association (CSA) approved protective helmet for ice sports by all participants, for their protection and safety during ice related activities at the Joe Byrne Memorial Stadium and Windsor Stadium is an important initiative for the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor, user groups and the public at large.

This policy is for the safety and well-being of all users while participating in ice related activities at the Joe Byrne Memorial and Windsor Stadium.

Policy

All participants during ice related activities at the Joe Byrne Memorial and Windsor Stadiums shall wear a Canadian Standards Association (CSA) approved protective helmet.

This policy will be clearly posted with the other established regulations for activities and placed at the entrance of the Joe Byrne Memorial and Windsor Stadiums.

Exceptions

1. Figure Skaters who are registered with Skate Canada and have successfully completed Stage 5 of the CanSkate program. Any figure skating competition that is sanctioned by Skate Canada and Skate NL are exempt from wearing a protective helmet during these activities as standard practice in the sport. This exception only pertains to Figure Skating activities.
2. Any personnel administering emergency first aid.
3. The policy will not apply to team personnel during bookings made by the teams associated with the Pro Hockey League.
